Often, Fats, Oils and Grease become a liquid from cooking, or they may be hidden within products such as dressings, mayonnaise and other foods that were cooked in oil and/or butter.

# Fort Collins Active Jook



F.O.G. builds up and creates havoc on the sewer system and pipes by causing clogs and sewer back-ups in your home and neighborhood.

Often times Fats, Oils and Grease are in liquid form and appear to wash down a drain. Garbage disposals break up chunks of food, but do not get rid of F.O.G. Instead, F.O.G. solidifies and collects on walls of pipes until they become clogged.

Soak up remaining Fats, Oils and Grease with a paper towel and dispose with your food in a garbage can.

Before you wash dishes, scrape food scraps from your plates, pots, and pans into your garbage can or compost container.

Avoid using your garbage disposal. Use sink strainers to catch any remaining food waste while washing dishes.
