



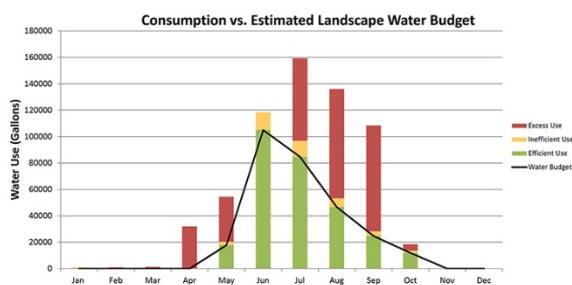
Landscape Budget Program

Participant Eligibility

- ❖ Program participants must be a Fort Collins Utilities customer with at least one commercial water tap.

Program Overview

Water bills can be a large expense for HOAs and businesses. Enroll in the free Landscape Water Budget program to see if you can save money by getting your landscape under budget. Like a financial budget, a water budget helps you make the best use of your resources by tracking water use and comparing it to water use goals determined by vegetation type, irrigated area, and weather. This program is only available to Fort Collins Utilities water customers with commercial water taps.



Water Conservation Staff will:

- ❖ Identify annual use based on landscape area, vegetation type, and local weather data. Staff will gather all necessary information to generate report.
- ❖ Participate in a one-hour site visit to review budget and basic opportunities.

We ask that the community manager/property manager, landscaper, facility manager, and HOA members attend the one-hour site visit to increase communication between groups and encourage common goals.

- ❖ Generate subsequent reports through the 2018 irrigation season outlining recommended water use and current water use. Subsequent reports serve as “check-ins” to see how the site is performing.

Steps to participate:

1. Identify parties who will receive reports (e.g. landscapers, HOA members, business owners, facility managers, etc.).
2. Identify primary contact for reports and subsequent communication with the City.
3. Sign-up to receive initial report [here](#).
4. After initial report request has been approved by City staff sign-up for one-hour site visit via link sent by Water Conservation staff.
5. Participate in one-hour site visit to review system and identify opportunities. We encourage all stakeholders (e.g. landscapers, managers, board members) to attend.
6. Receive subsequent reports via email through the 2018 irrigation season.
