DID YOU KNOW? On average, U.S. household leaks waste one trillion gallons of water every year – that's enough water to supply average annual use for 11 million homes. Most common types of leaks in the home are often easy to fix and can save about 10% on your water bill.


Toilets use the most water and are where the most common household leaks are found. On average, the typical toilet uses about 33 gallons of water every day. When a toilet leaks, the impact is like flushing the toilet an extra 50 times each day (up to 120 gallons) and can cost an extra \$100 a year.
