4:40 – 5:00 Review of our use of Bti larvicide (Broox Boze, PhD., Vector Disease Control International)

This discussion was tabled to allow for Boris Kondratieff to attend a future meeting.

5:00 – 5:15 Mapping of TAC Recommendation Process

Parker discussed the request from Council. Marr provided additional context regarding the request. Tyler provided background on Executive Leadership Team and the process used to seek additional/new recommendations. Levine requested presentation of any new information. Moore provided Fauver, 2015. Which promotes a vector index of somewhere between .25 - .5.

5:15 – 5:45 Human Cases Threshold

Staff provided a matrix from which to initiate conversation. This matrix provided a range of optional recommendation. Kunze provided thoughts on a "recommendation" and changing that to instead reflect discussion items, as it is unlikely that TAC can agree to recommend specific thresholds.

Kunze requested increased lead time for providing TAC with document going to Council. Two weeks is appropriate.

Boze suggested getting Dr. Greg Ebel in to discuss how the VI is calculated. Currently the VI is not calculated with pipiens consideration. The VI would typically be higher if pipiens were included.
